“The Sommeliers Focus”

One of California’s First AVAs, The Santa Cruz Mountain’s growing area is rich with wooded peaks and small vineyards tucked into quiet hillsides. The region is primarily known for Pinot Noir, Chardonnays and Cabernet Sauvignon. The Santa Cruz Mountain’s Appellation encompasses more than 850 square miles, beginning from the San Francisco Peninsula, to Silicon Valley and Half Moon Bay, continuing towards Gilroy, Monterrey and the Santa Cruz Bay.

It all began around 1853, when Scotsman John Burns planted the first commercial vines in the county. Burns named the mountain where his vineyard grew “Ben Lomond” (meaning Mount Lomond), which was the name of an old wine district in Scotland. Ridge Vineyards would be one of the first to follow Burns and to great success, Kathryn Kennedy would become a pioneering woman in America wine making moving on the hill in the wine making boom of the 1970s. Since its beginning with challenges and success’ Santa Cruz mountain wineries have become a premier wine growing region, with spectacular wines and amazing vistas. Cheers!!
